ANGEL GUARD

Angel Guard protects fresh silver from discoloration and oxidation with an invisible protective coating without using lacquer or other backing paint.

PROCEDURE FOR FLAT GLASS

- 1. Rinse the fresh silver well with distilled water.
- 2. Shake the bottle of Angel Guard well to mix the contents.
- 3. Pour into a clean trigger spray bottle and spray the silver well.
- 4. Allow it to sit on the silver for 5 to 10 minutes.
- 5. Rinse very thoroughly with sprayed distilled water. The Angel Guard is not soluble in water and can be difficult to rinse off.
- 6. When the piece is completely rinsed, allow it to air dry or dry it with clean, oil-free forced air.
- 7. Do not allow any water to dry in puddles.

PROCEDURE FOR BLOWN GLASS

- 1. Rinse the fresh silver well with distilled water.
- 2. Shake the bottle of Angel Guard well to mix the contents.
- 3. Pour enough Angel Guard into the container to coat the entire surface.
- 4. Roll the container around to get an even coating.
- 5. Allow the Angel Guard to sit on the silver for 5 to 10 minutes.
- 6. Tip out all of the remaining Angel Guard.
- 7. Pour in distilled water and shake the container to rinse it.
- 8. Repeat the rinsing process 2 more times.
- 9. Set the piece with the opening down so it can drain and dry.

Contains tetrachloroethylene, which is toxic. Use in a well ventilated area. Use a respirator. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear gloves and goggles. Keep out of reach of children.
